

Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

International Tin srl supports the ending of violence and human rights violation in the mining of minerals from the area known as the “Conflict Region” in the east of the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and surrounding countries.

The U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) has adopted rules to implement reporting and disclosure requirements related to “Conflict Minerals”, as directed by the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010. The rules require manufacturers to disclose whether the products they manufacture or contract to manufacture contain “Conflict Minerals” that are necessary to the functionality or production of those products.

International Tin makes a commitment to:

- Assure the conformity to such requisite, to require to its own suppliers to undertake a suitable survey with their supply chains to assure that the 3TG metals originate only from: mines and smelter out of the “Conflict Region” or mines and smelters certified as “Conflict free” from an independent third party if located inside the “Conflict Region”.
- Declare that our grades of Tin (II) Oxide and Tin (IV) Oxide don't originate from raw materials purchasing in the Democratic Republic of the Congo or one of its adjoining countries (Zambia, Angola, Central African Republic, Sudan, Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi and Tanzania) or are not from recycled or scraps sources.

In order to promote responsible Tin sourcing, International Tin also takes the following actions:

- Map its tin supply chain using The Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT);
- Check that Brand and Smelter, specified in each certificate of analysis, which comes with each tin metal purchase, would be in the conformant list of tin smelters on the CFSI site (<http://www.responsiblemineralsinitiative.org>) and conformant with the relevant RMAP (Responsible Minerals Assurance Process) Standards.
